## General Information About Your Property Tax



### When are my taxes due?

Your entire real estate tax bill, or your first installment, is **due by January 31, 2022**. If you choose to pay in installments, your first installment is due by January 31, 2022 and your second installment is due by July 31, 2022. Make note that the amount of your installments may vary. If you fail to pay the correct amount, at the correct time, to the correct place it will cause you to incur additional charges.

### When are Personal Property Taxes due?

They are due in full on or before January 31, 2022.

### Where can I pay?

All payments made on or before **January 31, 2022**, must be paid to:

### How can I pay the payment that is due by January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022?

Pay by Mail- Make your check payable to the Town of Dover Treasurer, write your tax parcel number on the check (to receive a receipt, enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope and mail it to: **Town of Dover**

Drop Box- A Black Drop Box is located on the North side of the Town Hall by the sidewalk. Checks only please.

Credit Card- Online Payments can be made at [www.townofdooverwi.com](http://www.townofdooverwi.com). Note the credit card company has a third-party service fee.

Pay In Person- Taxes can be paid at the Town Hall:  
Monday through Thursday 8a-4p and Fridays 8a-11a. The Town Hall will not be open December 24<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and January 3, 2022.

### Escrow & Refund Checks?

Wisconsin State Law requires tax bills be mailed to property owners. It is the home/property owner's responsibility to get the information to their lender. Cash refunds are not given. Refund checks will be issued after the check has cleared all banks.

### What happens if I pay late?

By State law, if you fail to pay the entire amount of your first installment by **January 31, 2022** then the option to pay in installments is no longer available. The entire balance then becomes due and will accrue interest and penalty until the delinquent amount is paid in full. Contact the County Treasurer for exact amount due.

### Is a Dog License Required?

Yes, by state law all dogs, 5 months or older, residing in Wisconsin are required to have a valid, current year dog license attached to their collar. Licenses are good for the calendar year, January 1-December 31<sup>st</sup>.

### What do I need to obtain a dog license?



You need to provide a copy of your dog's current Certificate of Rabies Vaccination. Separate payment from your taxes please.

### How much are dog licenses?

Neutered/Spayed \$5  
Unaltered \$10  
Late Fee after March 31- \$10 added  
Kennel license only w/ Board approval \$90.00 for the first twelve dogs. \$7.50 for each additional after twelve.

### Trash/Recycle Permit?

New 2022/2023 permits will be available for pickup. Signature is required for pickup.

Saturday Dec. 25<sup>th</sup> 2021 and Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> 2022  
Disposal hours reduced to 9a-1p only. No specialty items accepted.
