The proposed regulations are intended to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the community by promoting the safe, effective and efficient use of solar energy systems; Encourage the use of local renewable energy resources, including appropriate applications for solar energy; Promote sustainable building design and management practices to serve current and future generations; Efficiently invest in and manage public infrastructure systems to support development and growth.

This solar ordinance will apply to all unincorporated townships in Racine County which currently includes Burlington, Norway, Dover, and Waterford.
